Offerings



Industry Recognized Professional Certificate

A hybrid program offering networking opportunities with local industry leaders, career support, and weekly in-person meetings while completing an online professional certificate.



CompTIA A+ Certification

This program prepares students for the CompTIA A+ exam – the industry standard certification that indicates individuals have the skills needed to enter a wide range of information technology roles.



ERIE Pro Series

This offering utilizes career coaching, workshops and training sessions to focus on power and work-readiness skill development, including growth mindset development, LinkedIn profile creation, workplace communication, interview preparation and more.

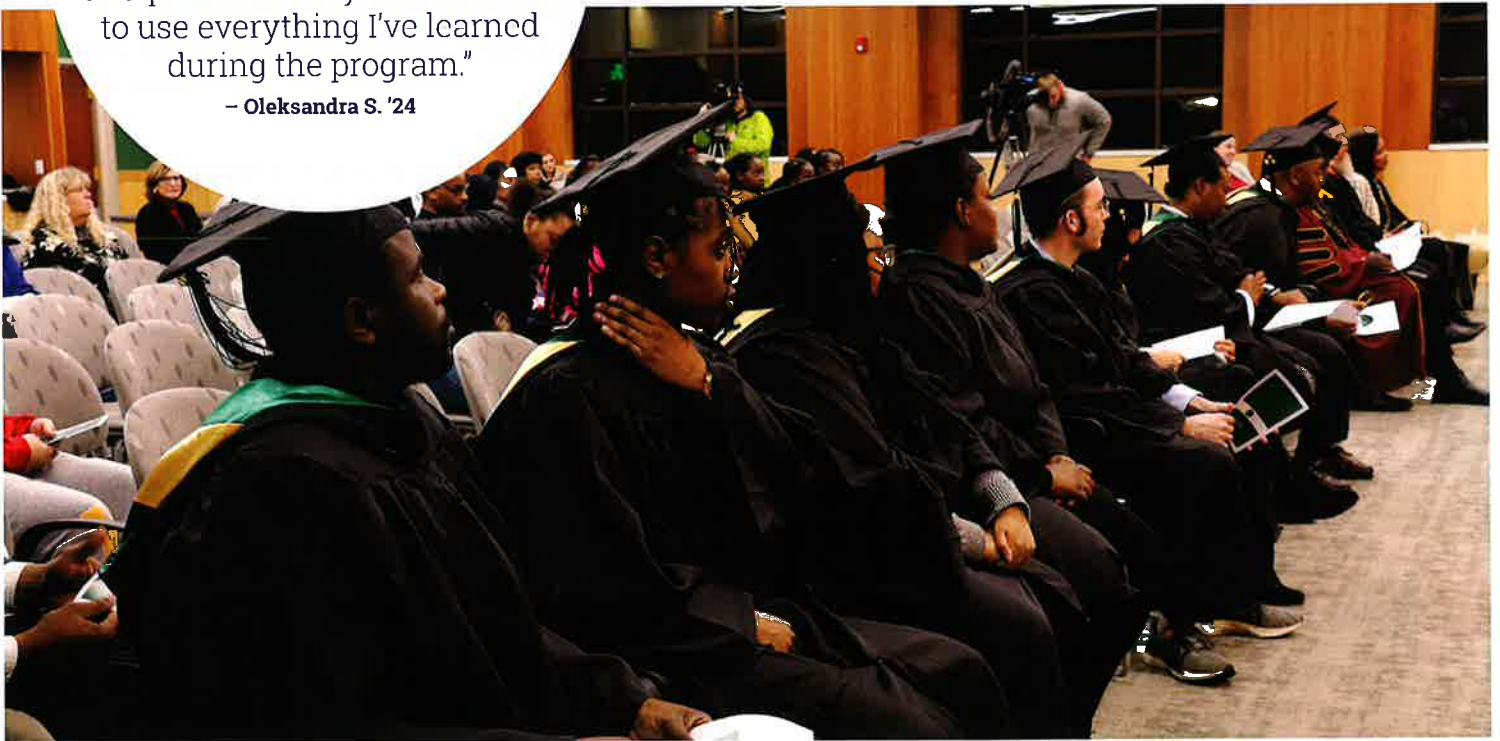
